Bouncer Operating Instructions

IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO FOLLOW THESE RULES:

1. Adult supervision is required at all times.
2. **For 15' Jump, 8-10 Children at one time, or 5-6 Adults. For 13' Jump, 5-7 Children. For 10' Jump, 3-4 Children, For 8' Jump, 3-4 Toddlers.**
3. Jumpers should be the same age group and relative size.
4. Users must remove shoes, eye glasses, and jewelry. Empty all pockets of any hard or sharp objects.
5. No Food, Drink, Gum, or Candy in unit.
6. No Silly String in or around unit.
7. Unit must be anchored down properly with Anchors provided.
8. Area required must be flat & free of animal droppings, stones, stumps, etc.
9. For the safety of all users, all outdoor use must have GFCI Ground Fault protection. All inside use must have proper grounded outlets (3-prong).
10. For the safety of all users, Extension cord must be for outside use, grounded, (3-prong) & Max. 50' Long. ***DO NOT ADD TO THE LENGTH OF EXTENSION CORD.
11. If unit becomes soft or starts to deflate, exit jumpers immediately and then check connections.
12. Any persons under the influence of drugs, alcohol, or acting in a rowdy or dangerous fashion must be removed immediately.
13. If severe weather should arise, close ride immediately.
14. DO NOT LEAVE UNIT DEFLATED IN RAIN OR OVERNIGHT. ROLL UP UNIT THEN COVER WITH TARP WHEN NOT IN USE.

By signing below, I hereby acknowledge that the above instructions were reviewed by me and that I understand the same. I am responsible for instructing all guests and invitees how to properly use the bouncer. I also understand and acknowledge the risk of any and all injuries to anyone using this equipment and for the property damage caused by same and indemnify and Hold Harmless Best Rentals, Inc. for any such injuries or damage.

		Inflatable Game	
		Weather conditions are safe for operation of all games	
		Vinyl/Patterns Clean and free of stains	
		Seams, and mesh are secure and in good condition	
		Tie down straps are strong with no breakage	
		Inflatable is staked in place, and will be anchored at all times	
		Inflatable is secured by sand bags, and will be anchored at all times	
		Entrance safety net is secure and in place	
		Entrance/Exits clear of obstructions and will remain clear	
		Entrance ramp is secure and attached	
		Warning signs are clear and visible	
		Internal air pressure is sufficient to give a firm footing.	
		No debris or sharp objects are present	
		Passageways are clear of obstructions	
		Ropes and footholds are strong and intact	
		Slide area is controlled by overhanging, cover	
		Inflatable is clear of any utility lines 20' above ground, laterally, and not exposed below ground	
		Accessories (If Applicable)	
		Blower is clean, and firmly attached to the inflatable	
		Blower is working and plugged into a GFC 110v outlet	
		If using a generator, use all manufacturer's guidelines for operation	
		Electrical cords are free from wear and do not pose any trip hazards to patrons or guests	
		Misters are firmly attached and working	
		Jousting poles are clean, strong, and secure	

Renter Initials	Owner/Rep Initials	Operator/Attendant Responsibilities	Comments/Action Taken
		Supervision by an adult trained attendant is required at all times	
		The Operator/Attendant should point out and make all riders aware of the Rules posted on the side of the game .	
		The inflatable MUST BE securely anchored at all times	
		Entry into the inflatable device should be orderly and in a controlled manner .	
		Riders should be of similar age range, height, and weight. Do not put older children or adults with younger children.	
		NO: Riders under the age of 3 years old	
		NO: Shoes, eyeglasses, jewelry, or other sharp objects	
		NO: Somersaults, diving, wrestling, rough play, or flips .	
		NO: Food, drinks, gum, pets, or silly string.	
		Do not jump onto or off of the ride.	
		Use of whistles and signaling devices is recommended	
		Keep patrons away from the blower at all times	
		DO NOT USE: and immediately deflate the inflatable if wind conditions exceed 15 mph and/or it rains	
		For Rides with Climbs and Slides	
		Go down the slide feet first only, and no more than one rider at one time.	
		NO: climbing up the slide the wrong way	
		NO: jumping onto the slide area	
		Emergency Procedures	
		<i>In the unlikely event of a severe Weather Alert, Power Failure, or a Medical Emergency:</i>	
		Exit patrons in an orderly fashion away from the game. Turn off the blower and unplug from the outlet	
		Keep patrons and guests away from the inflatable	
		Call the appropriate emergency responders if necessary
